



Code of Conduct - Parental Guidance

Supervision

- Wilton Tennis Club recommends that junior players aged under 11 are not left at the club without the supervision of a Parent or Guardian if attending to play a match or socially.
- If Junior Players are left unsupervised on the grounds or in the clubhouse outside of coaching lessons then Wilton Tennis Club is not responsible for their welfare.
- Junior players attending for coaching must be dropped off and collected on time, Coaches will be responsible for players for the scheduled duration of the lesson only.
- All players receiving coaching in year 1 or below must have a responsible adult present at the club during sessions. This rule does not apply during holiday camps.
- Parental supervision is not expected if a junior player is attending a camp at the club.

Clubhouse and Grounds

- Junior players and all other minors (e.g. younger siblings) should be actively supervised when in the clubhouse.
- All Junior players and all other minors must treat the clubhouse and all club equipment with care and respect. Any damage to club property will need to be paid for.
- Junior players and all other minors must not be allowed to go through the side gate at the end of the clubhouse, behind the clubhouse or behind the courts on the far side from the clubhouse.

Team Matches

- If a Junior player is on a team for Aegon Team Tennis or Surrey League then a Parent or Guardian must take the player to and from away team matches.
- Or the Parent or Guardian of the junior player must consent for the Team Captain to take the player to and from the match and ensure that the Team Captain has their relevant contact details in case of an emergency.

Medical Conditions

- Parents or Guardians must ensure that any pre-existing medical conditions are disclosed if a Junior Player is having coaching or playing matches at the club to the Head Coach or Team Captain as relevant.
- If a Junior Player requires any medication or necessary equipment due to a medical condition (e.g. an Inhaler for asthma) the Parent or Guardian must ensure that the player has this with them or can access it while playing at the club or playing an away team match another club.
